

In **English**, we'll be:

- Writing our character and setting descriptions.
- Understanding free verse poetry and performing poetry.

In **Maths**, we'll be:

- looking at area and how to measure it.
- Looking at equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions, tenths and hundredths, and adding and subtracting fractions
- Looking at decimals.

In **Science**, we will be learning about living things.

- We will be looking at how scientists group and classify animals.
- Drawing large-scale drawings of insects to help us study the details that scientists look at.
- Use classification keys to help group, identify and name living things in our local and wider environment.

In **French**, we will be looking at age, where we live and more on landmarks.
