In History and Geography:

- We'll learn how volcanoes are formed, why they erupt and the impact that these eruptions have.
- We will look at case studies of Mount Vesuvius and the more recent eruptions on Hawaii.
- We will also explore tornados and hurricanes and the impact these have on communities.

In English, we'll be:

- Writing a volcano escape story after studying the text 'Escape from Pompeii'.
- Writing a topic report articles about natural disasters

In Maths, we'll be:

- Focusing on our place value skills but using bigger numbers in their thousands.
- Then using these to develop our addition and subtraction skills.

In French, we will be recapping on our numbers and greetings, looking at more nouns including animals and how we use nouns and determiners in French.

In RE, Our topic for this term is 'How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?' <u>Topic</u> <u>Restless Earth</u> Year 4 In Science, we will be learning about states of matter.

- Differences between solids, liquids and gases.
- Exploring freezing and melting
- Looming at the water cycle, including evaporation and condensation.

In Computing, we will

 be continuing to develop our coding knowledge by creating programs with loops, events and conditionals and writing algorithms for everyday tasks.

In Art and DT, We will be

- Exploring the digital world and looking at Mindful moments timers.
- Developing our drawing skills.

In Music, we will be creating a soundscape using a range of instruments. We will focus on layers and rhythm.

In PE, we will be creating narratives through dance and working on cooperation, communication and consideration.

In PSHE, our topic is 'Being me', which gets to think about how we are unique and why we should celebrate this.
