- Please ensure all items are named (especially jumpers and PE hoodies)
- Please remember that PE kit is part of the uniform and the list should be adhered to: eg not patterned leggings or picture hoodies.

#### PARKING REMINDER

Schools are very busy places at drop-off and pick-up times and parking can be a challenge. The council has put restrictions in place for the safety and to aid the flow of traffic. Please bear in mind that the zig-zags outside of Willington site are not to be stopped on, even for dropping off, between 8am and 4:30pm. The bus bay at the front of the school in Cople is for buses only at all times: even if you are in a rush. In both villages, please be respectful of the residents and ensure that you are not parking too close to, or blocking, driveways. There are regular patrols by a traffic officer from Bedford Borough and several fines have been handed out in the last year.
