PARKING

Schools are very busy places at drop-off and pick-up times and parking can be a challenge. The council has put restrictions in place for the safety and to aid the flow of traffic. The bus bay at the front of the school in Cople is for buses only at all times. In both villages, please be respectful of the residents and ensure that you are not parking too close to, or blocking, driveways. There are regular patrols by a traffic patrol from Bedford Borough and several fines have been handed out in the last year.
