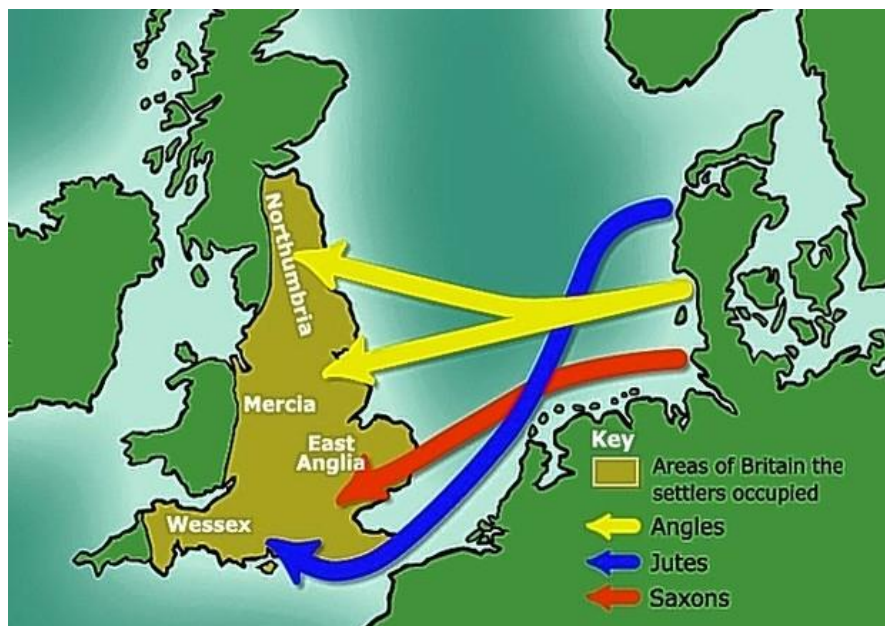
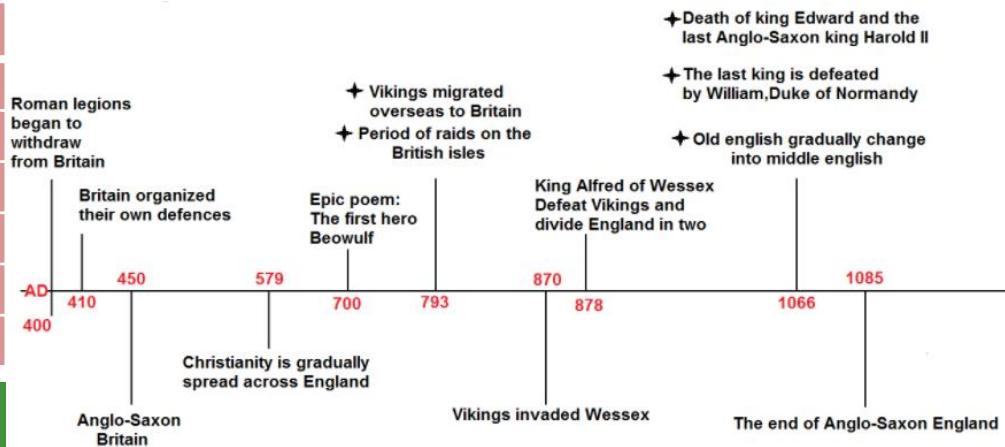


Key dates we will; be looking at.

400 AD	Roman legions began to withdraw
410 AD	Britain organised their own defences.
450 AD	Angles, Saxons and Jutes invaded Britain.
579 AD	Christianity is gradually spread across England.
700 AD	Story of Beowulf emerges.
793 AD	Vikings migrated to Britain.

Key Vocabulary

Angles	Tribes from modern day Denmark.
Christianity	A religion based on the teachings of Jesus.
missionary	A person from a religion sent to spread faith.
Pagan	A religion that involves worshipping many gods and goddesses.
Picts	Tribes originally from Scotland who were 'foul' and had a lust for blood.
Romans	Invaded and settled in Britain for over 400 years.
Saxons	German - Dutch tribes who settled in Britain from around 450 AD.
Scots	People from Ireland, who, like the Picts, were fierce and powerful fighters.
