In History and Geography, we'll be:

In English, we'll be:

- Comparing different types of poetry.
- We will learn the structures for limericks, Haikus and free verse as well performance poetry.

In Computing, we will

 be continuing to develop our coding knowledge by creating programs with loops, events and conditionals and writing algorithms for everyday tasks.

In French, we will be learning about homophones, adjective agreements, question words and adverbial phrases.

In RE, Our topic for this term is For 'Christians what was the impact of the Pentecost?' In Music, we will be creating Haikus and then creating a piece of music to fi this poem. We will also add sound effects.
