wild plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. Its doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows.

weeds	Weeds are wild plants that grow in places where people don't want them.
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter

Parts of a plant

roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.
stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrient from the roots to the leaves and flowers.
leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to make energy.
flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds.
petals	Petals are the colourful part of the flower.
fruit	Fruit contains the plants seeds
bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants
