### Key Ideas

Use world maps, atlases and globes	You will be able to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. You will be able to talk about which continents have rainforests .
Seasonal and weather patterns	We will review your learning about seasons and we will explore the location of hot areas of the world in relation to the Equator.
Physical / Human features	We will discuss the physical features found in the rainforests. We will also explore the human features that might be found there.

Key words	Explanation
continent	the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica)
oceans	a very large expanse of sea
human features	key human features include a village, farm, house – They are things that have been made by humans.
physical features	key physical features include forests, mountains, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather- They are things that are made/occur naturally.
equator	a line theoretically drawn on the earth which divides the earth into northern and southern hemispheres
atlas	a book of maps or charts
