Nounours/ les enfants	(when speaking to Teddy/children)
un, deux, trois	One, two, three
écoutez!	Listen!
regardez!	Look!
taisez-vous!	Be quiet!
croisez les bras!	Fold your arms!
asseyez-vous!	Sit down!

## Pronunciation

Silent final consonant	When a French word ends with a consonant it is nearly always silent, eg. The 's' in Paris.
U in tu	This sound does not exist in English. Listen in 'Comment tu t'appelle?'
U in un	This a nasal vowel so the n is not sounded.
