

## **COVID-19 Guidance**

(as of Summer Term 2022)

**Frequently Asked Questions** (based on information provided by the Local Public Health Team)

### **Should my child come to school if they have symptoms of a respiratory infection?**

If your child has mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat or mild cough and feels well, they may attend school.

If your child feels unwell or has a high temperature, they should stay at home.

### **Should my child take a COVID test?**

It is not recommended that children are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional.

### **If my child has taken a test and is positive, what should I do?**

If a child has a positive COVID-19 test result they should stay at home and avoid contact with others as much as possible for 3 days after they took the test. (The recommendation for adults is 5 days).
